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Company Markets Accreditation Programs To Several Business Sectors

While only three hotels so far have obtained **SafePlace Corp.**'s accreditation for proper safety and security measures, the company says as many as 400 hotels and motels are working toward accreditation. SafePlace/Wilmington, Del., rolled out its SafePlace Facility Accreditation Program in 2002. The latest hotel to get their certification renewed is **The Sagamore** in Bolton Landing, N.Y. SafePlace markets safety and security accreditation programs to sectors including commercial, healthcare, education and assisted living buildings. To become accredited, a hotel must undergo a three-step process, a SafePlace spokesman said. First, the property's staff must conduct a self-evaluation survey and complete an application. During a second step, a SafePlace authorized surveyor reviews the hotel. Lastly, SafePlace reviews results of the survey.
